H.S. MADAAN, J.

This revision petition is directed against the order dated 17.2.2018 passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Fatehgarh Sahib framing a charge for the offence under Section 306 IPC against accused Harmail Singh.

The FIR in question was registered by complainant Gurvinder Singh, who therein contended that his sister Karamjit Kaur was married with Harmail Singh (present petitioner) about 11 years earlier. There are allegations of Harmail Singh troubling and harassing his wife Karamjit Kaur and maintaining illicit relations with some other woman

and on protest being raised by his wife Karamjit Kaur, giving beatings to her. Karamjit Kaur had taken poison and committed suicide. In the FIR, the complainant had alleged that Karamjit Kaur had ended her life due to harassment by her husband Harmail Singh.

After registration of the FIR, the matter was investigated. After completion of investigation, challan was filed against the accused in the Court of law and thereafter charge for the offence under Section 306 IPC was framed vide the impugned order.

I have gone through the said order which is detailed one. The contentions raised by learned State counsel and defence counsel have been discussed and thereafter the Court found that a good prima facie case was made out for framing charge against the accused for offence under Section 306 IPC. The accused was charge-sheeted accordingly.

In the present case, I do not find any such illegality or infirmity with the impugned order much less apparent on the face of it. The order is certainly not in violation of settled principles of criminal jurisprudence, which might have called interference by this Court while exercising revisional jurisdiction.

Therefore, the revision petition is dismissed.
