This judgment shall dispose of aforementioned six civil writ petitions as common questions of facts and law are involved therein.

The facts are being taken from C.W.P. No. 15873 of 2013. The petitioners have sought quashing of Memo dated 18.10.2012 (Annexure P-3) issued by respondent No.5 raising demand for depositing Rs.1,61,137/- on account of balance amount of Employees Provident Fund.

A perusal of Annexure P-3 shows that it is a letter whereby Executive Engineer Punjab Mandi Board, Faridkot has sought information from the Establishment Officer (Construction) with regard to sending balance amount of EPF which remained pending against the petitioner(s).

Learned counsel for respondent Nos. 1,2 and 5 states that neither any deduction has been made till date nor any notice has been issued for the recovery. Annexure P-3 is an information sought by Executive Engineer, Punjab Mandi Board, Faridkot from the Establishment Officer (Construction).

In view of above, no cause of action has accrued to the petitioners to file the present petition(s) as through Annexure P-3

only certain information has been sought, which in no manner hurts the right of the petitioners. Consequently, all the writ petitions are dismissed.
