JASPAL SINGH, J (ORAL)

By virtue of instant petition preferred under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought an appropriate writ particularly in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to release arrears and gratuity along-with an interest @18% duly accrued in the name of petitioner's wife (since deceased) to him for the services rendered by her with the respondent.

At the very outset of arguments, it has been by respondents No.2 to 5 that all the retiral benefits along-with interest have already been paid/disbursed to the petitioner. As such, instant petition has rendered infructuous and be disposed of accordingly.

Dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.

However, in case petitioner still dissatisfied with amount or interest already paid to him, he shall be at liberty to approach this Court.
