The instant revision petition is directed against the order dated 25.10.2017 passed by the learned Special Judge, Mansa, whereby an application for discharge preferred by the present petitioners in FIR No.11 dated 24.7.2014 under sections 467, 468, 471, 120-B I.P.C, sections 13(1) (d) and 13(2) of Prevention of Corruption Act, registered at Police Station, Vigilance Bureau, Bathinda, has been dismissed.

Having argued the matter at considerable length, counsel prays for withdrawal of the instant petition.

Prayer is allowed.

Dismissed as withdrawn.

It is clarified that dismissal of the instant petition as withdrawal would not preclude the petitioners from raising all such pleas as may be available to them in their defence in accordance with law and before the Trial Court.
