The petitioner herein seeks to challenge the order dated 30.4.2018 passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Rupnagar, wherein the appeal preferred against the order dated 12.2.2013 passed by learned Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Anandpur Sahib, was accepted and the petitioners herein have been directed to vacate the house within a period of two months w.e.f. 25.5.2018.

In brief, the facts are that the petitioners herein had filed petition under Protection of Women from Domestic Act, 2005 (for short '**the Act**') seeking various reliefs therein. Along with the said petition, an application under Section 23 of the Act was also filed for grant of interim order regarding monetary help and right to residence. The trial court, vide order dated 12.2.2013, had directed the petitioners herein to vacate the property and shift to the premises, which had been taken on rent by the

husband. Other relief was also allowed to the petitioners herein as against the father-in-law and mother-in-law, who challenged the said order in Criminal Appeal No. 7174/16.3.2013, and came to be disposed of, in which the petitioners herein has been directed to vacate the said premises.

Aggrieved against the said order, the instant revision has been filed. This issue has already been decided by this Court on connected matter arising out of the same judgment in Criminal Revision No. 2435 of 2018, wherein this Court had disposed of the revision finding no infirmity in the orders so challenged, while also making a reference that in case the petitioners herein would file any application for execution of maintenance of the amount awarded, the same shall be decided expeditiously. No orders are called for in this revision.

Disposed of accordingly.
