This writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been filed for the issuance of a writ, in the nature of certiorari for quashing the order dated 22.06.2015 vide which petitioners have been relieved from their services as Lecturers in the respondent College and order dated 27.06.2015 vide which the respondent college has invited eligible candidates for appointment for the academic year 2014-15 by replacing the contractual services of the petitioners.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that the petitioners are working for the last 10 years and were appointed in general category whereas stand of the respondents is that reserve category candidate is to be considered as per instructions issued by the State Government. Furthermore,

in pursuance to advertisement issued by the respondents, the petitioner did not apply as per earlier practice and they could not be considered but they are continuing because of interim order passed by the Court.

During the course of the arguments, learned counsel for respondent-University has circulated a chart prepared on the instructions of the Principal of the Institution whereby prayer of the petitioners to join the institution has been allowed from 09.07.2018 as for current academic session teaching staff/faculty has already been appointed.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that chart is silent on the prayer of regularization.

Heard.

Considering the above, relief has been allowed to the petitioners, the present petition is disposed of. The petitioners, if so advised can make representation to the authority which shall pass an order in accordance with law.
