1. The present writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India to quash the order dated 17.04.2015 passed by the respondents.

2. In view of the reply filed by the Joint Director (Admn.) Department of Industrial Training, Haryana, Chandigarh on behalf of respondent Nos. 1 & 2, this petition has to be dismissed since claim of the petitioner is based on the same analogy as were the cases of other similarly situated employees who were party to CWP No. 17353 of 2009, titled 'Naval Singh and others Vs. State of Haryana' decided on 17.11.2014 (Annex P-6).

3. A speaking order has been passed rejecting the claim of those petitioners while deciding their representation under Court

directions and learned counsel for the present petitioner is unable to get out of the situation. Speaking order passed in that case would also apply in this case.

4. Consequently, the petition is dismissed with liberty to challenge the adverse order, if advised.
