ARUN PALLI, J. (Oral)

Learned State counsel submits that owing to the order dated 3.6.2016, the results as regards the post of Junior Engineer (Electrical) in all the four categories have not been declared. On the asking of the Court, the result of the petitioner, who had applied in SC category along with another candidate, was produced which shows that petitioner had secured 136 marks i.e. 118 in the written examination and 18 in the interview. Whereas the other candidate in his category (Roll No.12000863) has obtained 155 marks i.e. 136 in the written examination and 19 in interview.

Faced with this, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that nothing substantive survives in this petition and the same be disposed of as having become infructuous.
