The services of the three petitioner have been terminated pending litigation in the present proceedings. Two to the petitioners have retired from service.

Mr. Sanjiv Gupta, Advocate, submits that he may be given liberty to make a representation on behalf of the petitioner No.3 to the department to consider his name for promotion from the due date.

The present petition has become infructuous except for petitioner No.3. None can have any objection to the disposal of this petition with a direction to the competent authority to decide the representation of petitioner No.3 (whenever filed).

The present petition is hereby disposed of with the aforementioned liberty. In case the representation is filed within a week the same will be considered within next eight weeks by respondent No.2. In case petitioner No.3 is found entitled to promotion, the consequential benefits be given to him from the due date in accordance with law.
