As submitted by learned State counsel Mr. Navdeep Chhabra and is evident from short reply dated 19.04.2017 by way of affidavit of Rimpay Garg, Block Development and Panchayat Officer Lehra Garga, District Sangrur, Punjab-respondent No.4, the entire payment of CPF along with interest upto date i.e. Rs.3,21,631/- (CPF amounting to Rs.2,65,736/- and Rs.55,895/- as interest) has already been released by respondent No.3 through RTGS system to the petitioner.
