This is an application under Section 226 of the Constitution of India praying for parole to applicant-Harjinder Singh son of Bakhshish Singh who has been convicted and sentenced to undergo imprisonment for a period of 10 years in a case registered vide FIR No.22 dated 29.1.2015 under Section 21 and 29 NDPS Act at PS Gate Hakima, District Amritsar on the ground that the applicant-petitioner wants to meet his family members and to repair his house.

In the reply filed by the State, it has been specifically stated that the report has been submitted by Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran to the effect that the present applicant-petitioner can abscond from the parole and can again indulge in nefarious activities of handling narcotics. To the mind of this Court, no ground is made out for grant of parole to the petitioner. However, the respondents are

directed to reconsider the claim of the petitioner for grant of parole.
