Pursuant to the order dated 04.10.2017, report dated 15.02.2018, has been submitted by District Magistrate, Sonipat. According to this report, Sh. Ravinder son of Sh. Anoop was found at the brick kiln and he stated that he has taken over the lease of the said brick kiln since August 2017. Since that date, none of the persons named in the criminal writ petition has worked in his brick kiln, which was also confirmed by other labourers. He also submitted that M/s Keshri Bhatta Company had no communication with him.

2. Thus, the report has been submitted that the persons mentioned in the Criminal Writ Petition were not found at the said brick kiln.

3. None is present on behalf of the petitioner.

4. It appears that there is no truth in the averments mentioned in the writ petition as is borne out from the report dated 15.02.2018 of the District Magistrate, Sonipat.

5. The writ petition is dismissed.
