In the instant writ petition, petitioner has challenged the award passed by the labour court dated 08.08.2014 (Annexure P-3). While ordering notice of motion on 07.07.2015 learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that compensation awarded in lieu of back-wages does not commensurate with the service rendered by the petitioner from 1991 to 2008. The labour court passed award of compensation of Rs.30,000/- which would be too meagre in view of the Supreme Court decision the case of ***Bharat Sanchar Nigam limited Versus Bhurumal and another*** reported in (2014) 7 SCC 177. Therefore, award dated 08.08.2014 (Annexure P-3) is modified to the extent that petitioner is entitled to sum of Rs.5,00,000/-. Respondents are directed to extend the benefit of modified compensation of Rs.5,00,000/- within a period of six months from today failing which petitioner is entitled to interest on the enhanced compensation amount @ 6% per annum.

2. With this observation, petition stands disposed of.
