This application is for placing on record affidavit of Ashwani Kumar, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police (Investigation), District Tarn Taran.

The written complaint filed by petitioner was treated as criminal writ petition on judicial side.

Notice of motion was issued in the case on 09.11.2017.

In response to notice of motion reply has been filed by way of affidavit of Ashwani Kumar, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police (Investigation), District Tarn Taran. In the affidavit it has wrongly been mentioned that son of the petitioner was taken away by the Police from his

house. The son of the petitioner was apprehended on 27.10.2017 from the area of T-Point Morr Bhuse by ASI Paramjit Singh, In-charge, Narcotic Cell, Tarn Taran. Some recovery was also effected from him. FIR No.74 dated 27.10.2017 under Sections 21/61/85 of NDPS Act was registered at Police Station Sarai Amanant Khan and he was produced before the Court of Area Magistrate, Tarn Taran on 28.10.2017 and his remand was taken by the Police. Thereafter, again he was produced on 31.10.2017 and now he is in judicial custody.

Keeping in view the stand taken in the affidavit, there is no merit in the petition and same being devoid of any merit is hereby dismissed.
