The petitioner had initially sought her release at parole on the ground that she was expecting to deliver her child sometime in the month of December, 2017.

The application was initially filed on 01.12.2017 but thereafter re-filed on the next date. Notice of motion was initially issued for 13.12.2017.

It however transpires that in the meantime, one day before the scheduled date she actually gave birth to a female child, and both, the mother and child, are reported to be in good health as mentioned in the reply filed on behalf of the State.

Clearly in the given circumstances, the prayer made in the application at this stage has been rendered infructuous.

Ld. Counsel for the petitioner therefore, seeks to withdraw the present application with liberty to file a fresh one at an appropriate stage in

future on appropriate admissible grounds.
