1. Petitioner has prayed for issuance of a roving writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus in order to locate the detenues as mentioned in para no.4 of the petition.

2. District Magistrate, Patiala was impleaded on the oral submission of learned counsel for the petitioner on 08.12.2017 and notice of motion was issued to respondents No.1 and 6 only.

3. Reply by way of affidavit of District Magistrate-cum-Deputy Commissioner, Patiala on behalf of respondent No.1 has been filed. According to the reply, on receipt of order by this Court, directions were issued to Sub Divisional Magistrate,

Rajpura to verify the contents of the petition. The Sub Divisional Magistrate constituted a committee headed by Naib Tehsildar, Rajpura with Assistant Labour Commissioner and Sub Inspector P.S. Kheri as members of the Committee to inquire into the matter.

4. A report has been submitted by Naib Tehsildar, Rajpura to the effect that three members Committee after visiting the spot and after hearing the person present at the spot came to the conclusion that no labour was found to be bonded at the Brick Kiln of M/s Ganesh Gram Udyog Samiti Brick Kiln, Village Nardu, Tehsil Rajpura as alleged in the petition. There was no boundary wall nor any barbed wiring was found present to confine any labour.

5. Petitioner-Rotash and his family members were not found present at the brick kiln.

6. In view of above, no further action is called for in this petition.
