Prayer in this application is for modification of the order dated 19.01.2018, vide which a direction was issued to SHO, Women Police Station Sirsa, District Sirsa-respondent No.3 to produce respondent No.5 Gaganjot along with her two minor daughters namely Sirat and Hargun before this Court on 06.02.2018.

Counsel for the applicant-respondent No.5 submits that the petitioner has not disclosed in the petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying for issuance of a writ in the nature of habeas corpus that she has already filed a petition against respondent No.5 Gaganjot for declaring that Mandeep Kaur is the natural guardian of the abovesaid two minor daughters of the parties and the relief prayed for in this petition can be granted by the said Court, for meeting the minor children. It is thus submitted

that it will be convenient for the parties to arrange a meeting at Sirsa instead of directing them to come to Chandigarh during the examination days.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties, present application is allowed. Respondent No.3 is directed not to produce respondent No.5 as well as her two minor daughters named above before this Court.
