Prayer in this petition is for issuance of a writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus for releasing detainee-Manpreet Kaur. It is stated in the petition that petitioner-Gurpal Singh has married with the said detainee-Manpreet Kaur.

In pursuance to the order dated 19.12.2017, the SHO, Police Station Ghanaur, District Patiala has produced the detainee-Manpreet Kaur in Court today and her statement has been recorded before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court. In her statement, she has stated that she is residing with her parents as it is not possible for her to live with the petitioner because of the prohibited degree of relation with them.

Since detainee-Manpreet Kaur is major and is residing with her parents, it cannot be said that she is in illegal detention in any manner.

In view of the same, this petition is rendered as infructuous. The detainee is released and free to go back with her parents.
