RAJ MOHAN SINGH, J. (Oral)

This petition has been preferred by the petitioner under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India read with Section 482 Cr.P.C for issuance of writ in the nature of habeas corpus for issuance of direction to the official respondents to produce the alleged detainee namely Nancy daughter of Ved Singh.

On 21.12.2017, following order was passed:-

“The petitioner is seeking a writ in the nature of habeas corpus to produce his wife, namely, Nancy, who is stated to be illegally confined by the private

respondents, who are her parents and brothers.

Issue notice to respondents, returnable on 09.01.2018.

At the asking of the Court, Mr. Vikas Malik, learned Deputy Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3.”

Today, detenue Nancy has been produced in the Court.

Deputy Superintendent of Police, Gaur has filed reply by way of affidavit on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3.

Learned counsel for Nancy as well as for respondents No.4 to 7 stated that Nancy is not ready to go with the petitioner and is living in her parental house according to her own wish.

The Court has also enquired from Nancy who has stated in very categorical terms that she does not want to go with the petitioner and wants to live in her parental house.

In view of reply filed by respondents No.1 to 3 and the stand taken by Nancy, I am of the view that no further action is called for in this petition.

This petition is accordingly dismissed.
