The present petition has been preferred against the order dated 5.10.2018 dismissed the appeal filed by the petitioner against the order dated 18.9.2018 passed by learned Principal Magistrate Juvenile Justice Board, Hisar vide which the bail application filed by the petitioner was dismissed.

It is alleged by complainant-Narender that he was lodged in Observation Home, Hisar. On 26.10.2017, one Ankit and Vikas gave fist and slap blows and also pressed his throat. They compelled the complainant to sleep with Vivek and one Prince. Said Vivek also used abusive language against the caste of the complainant.

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Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is a juvenile and as per Section 12 of Juvenile Justice Act, he is entitled to bail.

Learned State counsel has opposed the prayer for the grant of bail to the petitioner.

Keeping in view the fact that the petitioner is a juvenile, the present is allowed and impugned orders dated 18.9.2018 and 5.10.2018 are set aside and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to the satisfaction of the concerned learned Principal Magistrate Juvenile Justice Board/Duty Magistrate.
