In the present petition, the claim which has been made by the petitioner is for the release of pensionary benefits. Notice of motion was issued. Reply has been filed by the respondents.

In the reply so filed, the respondents have also made a statement that all the benefits for which the petitioner was entitled for, have already been paid.

Counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner retired on 30.04.2016 whereas the amount was released much after the due date, which would entitle the petitioner interest on the delayed payments.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner will be satisfied in case a direction is given to the respondents to consider his case for the release of the interest on the delayed payments.

Let the petitioner make a representation to the respondents claiming the interest on the delayed payments and in case representation is received within four weeks from today, the respondents will pass appropriate orders as per law in respect of the grant of the interest on the delayed payments by passing a speaking order.

In view of the above, the writ petition is disposed of.
