Two petitioners, namely, Dharvinder Singh and Ranjit Singh, are primarily seeking their enrolment as Constable in the Information Technology and Telecommunications (in short 'I.T. & T') Wing, Punjab Police, pursuant to the selections made by the Punjab Police for appointment of Constables in the 'I.T & T' Wing of the State of Punjab. The petitioners' claim that they have been wrongly ignored for selection.

During the pendency of the present writ petition, an affidavit dated 06/23.02.2017 of Sh. Malwinder Singh Sidhu, AIG/Admn, IT&T, Punjab, has been filed on behalf of the all the respondents, wherein it is stated that the writ petition has become infructuous, as Sh. Dharvinder Singh (petitioner No. 1) has been appointed as Constable on 13.09.2012 in the District Police and Ranjit Singh (petitioner No. 2) has been enlisted as Constable (Operator) IT & T Wing of Punjab Police on 29.07.2015.

In view of the aforesaid factual position, it appears that the petitioners are not represented by their counsel since last two dates.

Dismissed as infructuous.

Since the main petition stands dismissed as infructuous, therefore, no order is required to be passed in the pending miscellaneous application(s), if any.
