H.S. MADAAN, J.

There is no representation on behalf of the petitioner. On the last date of hearing also, learned counsel for the petitioner had not put in appearance and some other counsel had appeared on his behalf. It was observed that in case learned counsel for the petitioner does not put in appearance on the next date of hearing, i.e. today, then the petition would be disposed of after going through the record.

Nobody has turned up to appear on behalf of the petitioner today.

Shri Inderbir Singh, Senior Superintendent of Police, District Sangrur in his affidavit dated 17.01.2017 has specifically mentioned in para No.2 that pursuant to order dated 09.01.2017 passed by this Court, Warrant Officer appointed by this Court alongwith SHO, Police station, City-I Malerkotla visited the house in question in which Maghar Singh, Malkiat Kaur and Gurmail Singh were statedly wrongly confined and found that main gate of the house was locked, which was thereafter broken and lock from inside was opened by Malkiat

Kaur and Gurmail Singh. Their statements were recorded in which they stated that they did not know who had locked the gate from outside. Then the Warrant Officer recorded DDR No.49 dated 04.01.2017 in Roznamcha, Police Station City-I Malerkotla in that regard and further a PCR has been deputed to keep close vigil in the beat in which the house in question is situated, to ensure the protection of life and liberty of such persons and to avoid any untoward incident and furthermore an FIR No.6 dated 10.01.2017 under Section 342 IPC, Police Station City-I, Malerkotla has been registered against unknown persons which is being investigated.

An affidavit of B. Chandra Sekhar, Inspector General of Police, Punjab, Patiala dated 22.03.2017 is also available on the record to the fact that enquiry in the matter has been held.

It being so, no further action in the matter is called for and the petition stands disposed of accordingly.
