In the instant writ petition, petitioner has challenged modified transfer order dated 10.07.2015 (Annexure P-8). His main grouse is that he is physically handicapped officer therefore, he is entitled to posting of his choice or nearby places as per his wish. He has been transferred from Ludhiana to Mumbai-Regional office. Pursuant to the order of transfer he has reported at Mumbai in the year 2015.

2. Learned counsel for the respondent submitted that as per Annexure A1 dated 15.12.2017 they have stated that as and when petitioner completes his minimum tenure at Mumbai (3 years) his grievance would be considered as per CVC guidelines and transfer of officers of the Bank

norms. In this regard, petitioner is hereby directed to submit representation in the month of June, 2018 so as to enable the respondent-Bank to consider his grievance in the month of July, 2018. The respondent-Bank is hereby directed to consider petitioner's grievance relating to transfer him from Mumbai to Chandigarh or nearby place with reference to number of posts stated in the Annexure A1 dated 15.12.2017 and pass a speaking order of transfer of the petitioner in the second week of July.

3. With the above observation, CWP stands disposed of with the consent of both the parties.
