A perusal of the recorded shows that vide order dated 22.9.2017, alleged detainee Darvinder @ Sanju was ordered to be produced on 9.10.2017. Reply by way of affidavit filed by Deputy Superintendent of Police (SD), Ferozepur was considered wherein it was mentioned that Darvinder Singh @ Sanju son of Raj Kumar was apprehended by the police and after conducting inquiry, he was released on the same day. Neither the detainee was produced nor the reply was filed on 9.10.2017. The case was adjourned for 2.11.2017. On 2.11.2017 petitioner, who was identified by ASI Ramesh Masih, submitted that her son Darvinder is presently living with her. Since the detainee was not produced by the police as per orders dated 22.9.2017 and 9.10.2017, explanation of Senior Superintendent of Police, Faridkot was called for and Darvinder

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was ordered to be produced on the next date i.e. 30.11.2017. On the adjourned date i.e. 30.11.2017, detenue Darvinder was produced in the Court along with his mother i.e. the petitioner. Petitioner again submitted that the detenue Darvinder was released by the police and is presently living with her. Since the explanation of Senior Superintendent of Police, Ferozepur was not filed, therefore, the case was adjourned for today.

Reply by way of affidavit of Senior Superintendent of Police, Faridkot has been filed in the Court. The satisfaction of the petitioner was recorded by the police and the detenue was allowed to go with her on the same day. Statement of the petitioner was also recorded that she has nothing to do with the police of Faridkot District and now her son is living with her.

In view of above, no further action is called for. Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
