AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

On 05.02.2018, the following order was passed:-

“ Counsel for the applicant-petitioner states that a bank draft of ₹ 1,50,000/-, which is the cheque amount, drawn in the name of respondent-complainant Rita Rani has been made available on behalf of the petitioner and that he would deposit the same with the Registrar of this Court. He further states that some reasonable compensation may be ordered by this Court or the petitioner may make an effort to compromise the matter with the respondent.

Notice of motion in the main revision petition as well as in the application for suspension of sentence for **02.04.2018**

subject to the depositing of the bank draft as mentioned above with the Registrar (Judicial) of this Court.

In the meanwhile, in case the above mentioned bank draft is deposited with the Registrar (Judicial) of this Court, the petitioner shall be released on interim bail till the next date of hearing subject to his furnishing personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, SAS Nagar (Mohali).

Copy of this order be given **dasti** to the counsel for the petitioner under the signatures of the Bench Secretary of this Court.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner will pay an amount of Rs. 16,000/- to the respondent as compensation amount, which is acceptable to the counsel for the respondent. The amount of Rs. 16,000/- has been paid in cash by the counsel for the petitioner to the counsel for the respondent in Court.

In the light of the above, the matter having been amicably compromised between the parties, the orders passed by the Courts below with regard to the conviction are confirmed, however, the sentence is reduced to the one already undergone.

The bank draft deposited by the petitioner in the name of the respondent amounting to Rs. 1,50,000/-, in compliance with the order dated 05.02.2018, be released to the counsel for the respondent on an application moved in this regard forthwith.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
