In compliance to the order passed by this Court, dated 22.2.2018, learned State counsel has filed an affidavit dated 12.4.2018 of the Joint Director, office of Director Elementary Education Haryana, and submits that pursuant to an order dated 4.4.2018 (Annexure R-1), the petitioner has since been granted extension in service w.e.f. 1.7.2015 to 30.6.2017, and the said period shall also be treated as duty period/qualifying service for all the pensionary benefits and salary benefits. He submits that the entire arrears, admissible to the petitioner, shall be released within a period of six weeks from today.

That being so, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that nothing substantive survives in this petition and the same be disposed of as such.
