Petitioner had competed for appointment to the 10 posts of Assistant District Attorney reserved for the Scheduled Caste (R&O) category pursuant to the advertisement dated 24.09.2015. Petitioner was placed at merit no.11 i.e. the first in the waiting list against the aforesaid post in the said category.

The Challenge is to the selection of four of the candidates, namely, Tejinder Pal, Arun Kumar, Bikramjeet Singh and Anuj Kumar placed in the main merit list of the Scheduled Caste category on the ground that they were ineligible as they did not possess the prescribed two years experience of practice at the district Bar.

At the time of hearing, counsel for the petitioner states at Bar

that the present writ petition becomes infructuous as the Petitioner in the meanwhile has been appointed as ADA.

In view of the statement of the counsel at the Bar, present writ petition is hereby dismissed as infructuous.
