The petitioner was working as Primary Teacher with the Guru Nanak Public School, Mullanpur, run by respondent No.2/Trust and affiliated with CBSE/respondent No.4. By filing the present petition, a challenge was laid to the Notice dated 16.05.2015 (**Annexure P-1**), ordering the petitioner to be relieved w.e.f. 16.08.2015.

This Court, vide order dated 12.08.2015, had stayed her relieving from her services.

A reply on behalf of the contesting respondent Nos.2 and 3 has been filed, seeking to justify her termination because of the overall performance of the petitioner.

Be that as it may, at the time of hearing, learned Counsel for the petitioner states that the present petition has become infructuous as the petitioner has since superannuated w.e.f. 30.06.2017.

Accordingly, the present writ petition is disposed of as infructuous.
