RAJIV NARAIN RAINA J.(Oral)

1. By way of this petition filed under Articles 226 & 227 of the Constitution, the petitioner seeks a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to make correction in the name of petitioner as 'Harender Singh' instead of 'Harender Singh Dindey' in the matriculation examination DMC/Certificate issued by respondent No.3.
2. Today, CM No.15588 of 2018 filed by the petitioner for exemption from filing certified/typed copy of Annexure P-10 (Aadhar Card) and to place on record the same is listed for hearing. C.M. No.13829-CWP-2018 filed by the petitioner for placing on record his affidavit as Annexure P-9 is also listed for hearing. In the affidavit, the deponent has sworn and

deposed as follows:

“1. That the deponent has filed the above mentioned writ petition seeking writ of mandamus to give a direction to the respondent No.3 to make correction in the name of petitioner as “Harender Singh” instead of “Harender Singh Dindey” in matriculation examination certificate (Annexure P-1).

2. That the deponent hereby declares that he has not incurred any civil or criminal liability with his previous name i.e. “Harender Singh Dindey” as recorded in above said matriculation certificate and there is no criminal case pending against the deponent in any Court of law with above said name.

3. That the deponent declares that in all other educational qualifications certificates except above said matriculation certificate (Annexure P-1) the name of deponent is recorded as “Harender Singh”.

4. That the deponent request to the Hon'ble Court that respondent No.3 be directed to correct his name as “Harender Singh” instead of “Harender Singh Dindey” in matriculation certificate (Annexure P-1).”

3. In support of his case, the petitioner has also annexed photocopy of his Aadhar Card.

4. In view of the contents of the affidavit reproduced above as well as the documents annexed with the writ petition, the learned counsel for the respondents states that the Board of School Education, Haryana, Bhiwani has no objection to carry out the necessary correction, as now BSEH, Bhiwani is rendered safe.

5. Accordingly, this petition and the applications for placing on

record the affidavit and the Aadhar Card are allowed. The respondent-Board is directed to make necessary corrections in its record and issue fresh matriculation examination DMC/certificate to the petitioner after incorporating his correct name within seven days on return of the old original DMC/certificate.

6. The HBSE, Bhiwani while issuing fresh/corrected DMC/certificate will record in the certificate that '*the correction in respect of petitioner's name is as per the orders of the Punjab & Haryana High Court in CWP No.10170 of 2017*'.
