Certain clauses of the Teachers Transfer Policy-2016, which regulates the transfers of teachers working in the School Education Department, Haryana are in question. The petitioners have set out multiple grounds in support of their claims. However, during the course of hearing, learned counsel for the parties have reached a consensus that the petitions at hands shall be considered as representations on behalf of the petitioners and the competent authority i.e. Additional Chief Secretary (respondent No.1)

shall pass appropriate orders, in accordance with law, within a period of three months from today. And, in the event, it is deemed necessary, the petitioners shall also be afforded an opportunity of hearing.

That being so, the petitions are disposed of in the above terms. In the event, the department declines the claim of the petitioners, a comprehensive order, shall be passed assigning reasons in support thereof.
