ARUN PALLI, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner was engaged as Sweeper on daily wages by the respondent department on 1.2.1992. However, her services were terminated on 1.2.1997. But the Labour Court, vide its award dated 19.4.2006 (Annexure P-1), ordered her reinstatement with continuity of service and 50% back wages. Concededly, the award rendered by the Labour Court has since attained finality. Meaning thereby, as of today, the petitioner has served the respondent department for over 25 years. The limited grievance that she has is; that one Raj Pal son of Baldev, who was appointed much later than the petitioner, i.e. on 1.7.1995, as Chowkidar and served in the same office, has since been regularised vide order dated 20.1.2017; in compliance to the decision of this Court, dated 4.4.2016, rendered in CWP No.22606 of 2012 (Annexure P-4), filed by aforesaid Raj Pal. Thus, her services too ought to have been regularised in terms of government notification dated 1.10.2003.

The factual position, as narrated above, is not disputed by the learned counsel for the respondents. Rather, he submits that this petition itself shall be considered as representation on behalf of the petitioner, and her claim shall be examined and dealt with within a period of eight weeks from today. And appropriate orders in accordance with law shall be passed.

The petition is accordingly disposed of in the above terms. However, in the event the claim of the petitioner is declined, the respondent authorities shall pass a comprehensive order assigning reasons in support thereof.
