JITENDRA CHAUHAN.J.(ORAL)

At the outset, learned State counsel, on instructions, states that after investigation, it was found that the charge-sheet filed against the petitioner was ill-conceived and the competent authority has taken a decision to withdraw the same as no substance was found in the allegations raised against the petitioner with regard to selling lesser area of land to one M/s Tilak Ram Kisan Chand.

In view of above, the present civil writ petition is allowed. The impugned charge-sheet dated 23.05.2005 (Annexure P-5), inquiry report (Annexure P-7), punishment order dated 06.07.2012 (Annexure P-9) and order dated 26.06.2015 (Annexure P-12) are set aside. All the necessary benefits shall be given to the petitioner within four weeks from the date of receipt certified copy of the order. If the needful is not done in the stipulated period, the petitioner shall have

liberty either to revive the present petition or to file a fresh one on the same cause of action.
