ARUN PALLI, J. (Oral)

The petitioner competed for selection to the post of Assistant Professor Biochemistry, pursuant to an advertisement No.1 of 2017, issued by the Kalpana Chawla Government Medical College, Karnal (respondent No.4). The limited grievance that she had was, for, she was working as Demonstrator with the 3rd respondent, to participate in the process of selection, and consequential appointment, she was required to obtain the no objection, as also the experience certificate from her current employer. Whereas, she was not issued these certificates, and thus, this petition.

Vide an interim order dated 17.05.2017, this Court had directed respondent No.4 to permit the petitioner to participate in the selection process, but they were restrained from pronouncing her result.

Learned counsel for the respondents has produced the results

of the candidates, which is taken on record as Mark-A, who competed for selection to the post in question, which shows that petitioner had obtained 70.75 marks, whereas one Dr. Bela Goyal had secured the highest marks i.e. 79. But since Dr. Bela Goyal did not chose to join, and next candidate i.e. Dr. Meenakshi Puri, who had obtained 74.49 marks, was offered an appointment, against the only advertised post. And she has since joined. It is accordingly urged, for the petitioner failed to qualify for selection, nothing substantive survives in this petition.

Faced with this, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petition be disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.

Ordered accordingly.
