This writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been filed for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing of order dated 28.07.2014 (Annexure P-3) passed by respondent No.2 whereby claim of the petitioner for government job under the policy (Annexure P-2) against land of the petitioner acquired for Peona Power Plant at village Gobindpura, District Mansa, had been rejected.

Contents that the land of the petitioner is 22.67 marlas and therefore, the petitioner is not entitled for appointment as per the Policy/Guidelines dated 03.03.2014 (Annexure P-2) issued by the Government of Punjab, as for becoming eligible under the said Scheme, minimum land required for acquisition is 4 kanals i.e. 80 marlas. He further contends that the petitioner had the land acquired by his uncle, namely, Sher Singh and is taken in to consideration, the same would come to be more than 80 marlas, rendering the petitioner eligible for consideration for appointment

as per the Policy/Guidelines (Annexure P-2).

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and have gone through the case file.

The case of the petitioner is not covered by Annexure P-1 i.e. letter No.10/88/2010-USN-1001 dated 08.11.2011 regarding giving public employment to one member of the family whose land has been acquired for Piona Power Thermal Plant.

In view of the above, no case for interference is made out.

Dismissed.
