This is a criminal revision that has been filed seeking to challenge the maintenance that has been awarded by the District Judge, Family Court, Ambala, to respondent-Neha Gupta. Along with the criminal revision, an application has also been filed under Section 5 of the Limitation Act, seeking condonation of delay of 655 days in filing the criminal revision.

When this matter was taken up for hearing for the first time on 05.02.2018, learned counsel for the petitioner sought an adjournment to place on record copy of decree of divorce granted to respondent-wife, but that order has not been complied with despite several adjournments.

On the last date of hearing i.e. 17.07.2018, learned counsel for the petitioner had again sought some more time to comply with the order dated 05.02.2018 and address arguments. This court had noted that the

instant criminal revision has been taken up on several occasions, however, there was no adequate representation or arguments addressed by the counsel for the petitioner. On the said date, it was also noted that there was no ground made out to adjourn the case, but keeping in view the larger interest of justice, one last opportunity had been granted to the counsel for the petitioner to address arguments, failing which it would be deemed that the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the matter.

The case has been called twice today, however, no one put in appearance on behalf of the petitioner, nor the order dated 05.02.2018 has been complied with.

Under these circumstances, this court has left with no option, but to dismiss the instant criminal revision for want of prosecution as well as for non-compliance of the order.

Ordered accordingly.
