Convict-Azruddin has filed the present petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India read with Section 3 sub sections 1(b) and 2(b) of the Haryana Good Conduct Prisoners (Temporary Release) Act, 1988 for issuance of directions to the respondents to grant parole to him for a period of four weeks so as to enable him to solemnize the marriage of his sister which is fixed for 10.2.2018.

Upon notice, learned State counsel has filed the reply. It has been stated therein that the petitioner is a hardcore prisoner and, therefore, not entitled to the relief of parole. It has also been stated that he has one another brother who is older to him. Further, in case he applies to the Jail Authorities for release

on parole for the purpose of attending the marriage of his sister, he can be sent under an armed police escort for a period of forty eight hours to be decided by the concerned Jail Superintendent.

In view of the fact that the petitioner has one another brother, as mentioned in para 7 of the petition, this Court finds that he does not deserve to be released on parole. However, directions can be issued to the Jail Superintendent to make arrangements for sending him under armed police escort so as to enable him to attend the marriage of his sibling i.e. sister.

Resultantly, the petition is disposed of with a direction to the Superintendent, District Jail, Faridabad to make arrangements for sending the petitioner under an armed police escort for a period to be decided by the Jail Superintendent, so that he may attend the marriage of his sister.

An attested copy of the order under the signatures of the Court Secretary of this Court is being handed over to learned State counsel for compliance.
