Pursuant to order dated 05.02.2018, status report by way of affidavit of Jaspal Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, (Rural), Ferozepur, District Ferozepur, has been filed in Court and the same is taken on record. According to this affidavit, the husband of the complainant, namely, Kehar Singh, was arrested on 23.01.2018 and five grams of heroin was recovered from him. Consequently, FIR No.23 dated 23.01.2018 has been registered at Police Station, Sadar Ferozepur, under Section 21 of the NDPS Act, 1985. Thus, the aforementioned Kehar Singh is not in illegal custody. The affidavit further states that there are five other FIRs registered against Kehar Singh, four of which are under NDPS Act, 1985.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI-Mehal Singh, further submits that Kehar Singh has now been released on bail.

In view of the above, nothing survives in this petition and the same is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
