Prayer in this petition is for issuance of a writ in the nature of Habeas corpus for issuing direction to respondents No. 2 to 4 to release the detenues, namely, Anma and Reshma from the custody of respondents No. 5 to 14.

In compliance of the order dated 17.04.2018 passed by this Court, a status report by way of Affidavit of Senior Superintendent of Police, District Amritsar (Rural) has been filed in Court today, which is taken on record.

As per the affidavit both the detenues were recovered and after recording their statements, they have stated that they do not want to get their medical examination conducted, nor they want to get their statements recorded before the Court below. Their custody has been handed over to Shahdeen (father of the petitioner-Makhandeen). In this regard, photographs have also been attached as Annexure R-1.

In view of the above, this petition has been rendered infructuous and is disposed of as such.

However, liberty is granted to the petitioner in case the petitioner will apprehend the life and liberty of the detenues, he can move fresh petition for redressal of the same.
