Petitioner has filed the instant writ petition under Article 226 of the Constitution seeking setting aside of the order dated 18.07.2016 (P-4) passed by the respondent no.2 qua the petitioner whereby he was transferred from GSSS, Bariar to GSSS Khawaja Vardoag.

This Court while issuing notice of motion on 22.07.2016 passed the following order:-

*“ Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been transferred during mid session and that too when ban is there on transfers. He further submits that under similar circumstances, one Neelam has approached this Court by way of filing **CWP No.13721 of 2016**, wherein, notice of motion has been issued and operation of impugned order has been stayed. The said case is now fixed for hearing on 27.07.2016.*

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. L.S. Virk, Additional Advocate General, Punjab, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State.

Adjourned to 27.07.2016.

Meanwhile, operation of impugned order shall remain stayed.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is directed to supply three copies of the petition to learned counsel for the respondent-State during course of the day. ”

At the time of hearing, learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that the present petition has become infructuous as the transfer order has been cancelled.

Dismissed as infructuous.
