The present petition has been filed for grant of parole for agriculture purpose for six weeks.

The petitioner has submitted that agriculture is the only source of income of his family and his wife, old parents and little children are unable to do the agriculture work and, therefore, he be released on parole for six weeks to cultivate his land.

For the above purpose, the petitioner had moved an application through the Jail Superintendent, District Jail, Faridabad, which had been rejected by the District Magistrate, Palwal vide order dated 21.12.2017, leading to the filing of the present Criminal Writ Petition.

Learned State counsel has filed short reply by way of affidavit of Anil Kumar, Superintendent, District Jail, Faridabad and the same is taken on record. As per this affidavit, another application dated 13.02.2018 has been moved on behalf of the petitioner for parole and the same is under consideration.

In view of the above, this petition is disposed of with directions to

pass an appropriate order thereon within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
