RAJ MOHAN SINGH, J. (ORAL)

This petition has been preferred under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of directions or roving writ in the nature of habeas corpus for the release of alleged detainee, namely, *Kiranjeet Kaur daughter of Baljit Singh and Ramninderjit Kaur (present petitioner)* from illegal confinement of respondent No.4-Boota Singh.

Notice of motion was issued on 08.02.2018 and respondent No.3 i.e. SHO, Police Station City Zira, District Ferozpur was directed to produce the alleged detainee-Kiranjeet Kaur, daughter of the petitioner in the Court.

On 19.02.2018, learned State Counsel sought time to comply with the aforesaid order dated 08.02.2018 and the case was ultimately adjourned for today.

It has been brought to the notice of this Court that the run away marriage couple had filed CRM-M-37334 of 2017 for protection of their lives and liberty in this Court which was disposed of vide order dated 04.10.2017 with a direction to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Ferozepur to consider and decide the representation of the couple within the framework of law.

Today, Kiranjeet Kaur, daughter of the petitioner has been produced in Court. Learned counsel appearing for respondent No.4- Boota Singh has informed the Court that Kiranjeet Kaur has solemnized marriage with respondent No.4-Boota Singh on 04.10.2017 on attaining the age of majority. Since then they are leading happy married life.

Alleged detenue-Kiranjeet Kaur, who is present in Court has also endorsed the aforesaid version and further stated that she is living happily in the matrimonial home with her husband, namely, Boota Singh.

In view of the above, no further action is required to be called for in the present petition.
