Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the daughter of the petitioner, namely Jyoti Sharma, is a minor and that she has been enticed by one Ajay son of Vasudev. Consequently, an FIR was registered against said Ajay son of Vasudev and he has been arrested. The daughter of the petitioner is allegedly in a protection home at Nuh.

In view of the fact that whereabouts of daughter of the petitioner are known and she is not missing, therefore, the present petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, seeking writ in the nature of habeas corpus, is not maintainable.

The petition is dismissed.
