Prayer in this petition is for issuance of a writ of habeas corpus directing respondents No. 4 to 6 to hand over the custody of the detenuue i.e. Rupinder Kaur, wife of the petitioner-Jagsir Singh along with three minor children, namely, Varinder Singh, Harinder Singh and Surinder Singh.

The matter was referred to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of the Court for recording the statements of the parties. The detenuue-Rupinder Kaur, who is present along with her minor children has deposed that her husband-Jagsir Singh-petitioner is maltreating her on account of bringing less dowry and she was thrown out of her matrimonial home on

19.5.2010 and since then she has been residing with respondents No. 5 and 6, who are her father and brother. Respondent No.4-Sukhmander Singh is their neighbour and has nothing to do in this case.

In view of the statement, no further action is required in the present petition and the same is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
