Present petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of a writ in the nature of Habeas corpus.

In compliance of the order dated 23.02.2018 passed by this Court, Ms. Manjeet Kaur daughter of Niranjana Singh has been produced before this Court today and she has made the following statement:

“I am 28 years old. At Present I am staying with my parents. I do not want to reside with my parents. I performed marriage with present petitioner-Ajay on 01.02.2018, who is present in the Court out of my own free will. I do not want to go to the house of my father i.e. respondent No.5 and want to go with my husband-Ajay.”

Even respondents No.4 to 6 are present in the Court.

In view of the categorical statement of Manjeet Kaur that she is 28 years of age and has performed marriage with petitioner-Ajay on 01.02.2018 out of her own free will; she was not detained by her parents;

that she wants to stay with petitioner-Ajay, she would accompany him to his home from the Court premises itself, the present petition stands disposed of in the above terms.
