It appears that on 19.02.2018, a complaint was addressed to the High Court with the allegations that on 18.02.2018, husband of the petitioner-Sukhwinder Kaur went missing when he went to Ferozepur to meet his relatives. Husband of the petitioner did not reach his destination.

The complaint was treated to be a crl. writ petition and was placed before the Co-ordinate Bench of this Court on 05.03.2018 and following order was passed:-

"It is alleged in the complaint sent by complainant Smt.Sukhwinder Kaur to Hon'ble the Chief Justice that on 18.2.2018 at about 1:00 p.m., her husband Lakhwinder Singh had gone from bus stand, Amritsar to Ferozepur to

meet his relatives but he did not reach the destination and his mobile phone is also switched off. Therefore, his whereabouts be got ascertained.

Notice of motion for 20.3.2018.

Senior Superintendent of Police (Rural), Amritsar and Senior Superintendent of Police, Ferozepur are directed to conduct a probe in the matter and then submit report to this Court on before the the next date of hearing.”

In compliance of aforesaid order dated 05.03.2018, status report has been filed by the Police, wherein statement dated 18.03.2018 (Annexure R-1/T) made by the petitioner has been relied to say that on 23.02.2018 husband of the petitioner had come back home safely after staying with his relatives. He was not kidnapped by any one. The complainant also stated that she does not want any action to be taken on her complaint and the same be consigned.

In view of above, no further action is called for.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
