A written complaint was sent by brother of the detainee Ravi Shankar stating that his brother namely Ritesh Kumar has been kept in illegal custody by the bank officials.

Notice of motion was issued in the case on the basis of written complaint. In response to notice of motion reply has been filed in the Court today and the same is taken on record.

Learned State counsel submits that the brother of the petitioner was not kept in illegal confinement by the bank officials. It was verified by deputing some police official that the petitioner and his brother had gone to their native village which is in State of Uttar Pradesh. There was a telephonic talk with the petitioner and it was disclosed that his brother who is alleged detainee has gone to his native village in State of Uttar Pradesh.

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Even on telephonic talk with the alleged detainee, the factum of his visit to his native village has been affirmed.

In view of the stand taken in the reply, nothing survives in the present petition and the present petition is dismissed.
