A written complaint was sent by petitioner Jitender Kumar, which was addressed to Hon'ble the Chief Justice of this High Court stating that on 22.02.2018, the local police, Faridabad took away his two younger brothers namely Narinder and Vishwas and his father namely Ramjanam Mehto to some unknown place in some false case and in spite of all efforts, they were not searched out.

Said complaint was treated as Criminal Writ Petition No.265 of 2018, wherein notice of motion was issued on 15.03.2018. In response to the notice of motion, reply has been filed which is on record.

On the basis of the reply, learned State counsel submits that neither brother of the petitioner namely Narinder nor his father namely

Ramjanam Mehto were taken away by the local police, Faridabad. Gago Devi mother of the petitioner has stated that on 17.04.2018 Narinder and her husband Ramjanam Mehto were working in a company situated at Udyog Vihar, Gurugram and they were on duty. Against another younger brother of the petitioner namely Vishwas, a case i.e. FIR No.103 dated 24.01.2018 under Sections 457, 380 and 411 IPC was registered at Police Station Central, Faridabad.

Keeping in view the stand taken in Para No.4 of the reply, there is no merit in the present petition and the same, being devoid of any merit, is hereby dismissed.
