The present petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus to appoint a warrant Officer to locate detainee namely Manju who is stated to be in illegal custody of respondent Nos.5 to 8.

Notice of motion was issued on 21.03.2018. Petitioner is mother of the detainee namely Manju who is present in the Court. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the detainee submits that detainee-Manju and her husband Balwinder Singh filed CRM-M No.8282 of 2018 for protection of their life and liberty and said petition was disposed of on 26.02.2018 with a direction to respondent-authorities that life and liberty of the petitioners be protected as they were apprehended threat at the instance of their parents and other family members. Detainee-Manju is also

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present in the Court and she has stated in the Court that she has solemnized marriage with Balwinder Singh and there is threat at the instance of private respondents. She has also stated that she is happy in her matrimonial home and she is not in illegal custody of any person.

Petitioner as well as father of alleged detainee have been allowed to meet in the Court. Accordingly, it cannot be said to be a case of illegal detention and therefore, petition being devoid of merit is hereby dismissed.
