Reply by way of affidavit of Ajay Kumar, HPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Radaur (Yamuna Nagar) on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 4 filed has been filed in Court today and the same is taken on record. In terms of the order dated 04.04.2018 passed by this Court, the Warrant Officer has submitted his report dated 06.04.2018. The relevant part of the report is as under:-
